## SPECIAL EVENTS

**HATS OFF TO THE ARTS – Friday, June 25** In just two years, HATS OFF TO THE ARTS has become a signature art event in America's hometown. Held in the historic Russell Gallery and The Lindens building at The Plymouth Center for the Arts, over the first two years, the galas have drawn nearly 600 patrons and talented artists to dine, dance and appreciate art while raising nearly \$100,000 in support of art and cultural programs presented at the Center.

This year's event will feature a special salute to painters and the preservation. We will celebrate the artistic and cultural opportunities presented by the Center, as well as its significance as a building listed on both the State and National Historic Registers. Funds raised will be used to restore the exterior of the Lindens. Artists will present paintings, sculptures, jewelry, and fine crafts for sale.

### **Gallery Information**

*The Plymouth Center for the Arts has two main art galleries. The **Russell Gallery** displays artwork by juried Guild artists and is also used as a venue for small performances, functions, and larger meetings. The **Member's Gallery** is used to display unjuried artwork by Guild members and includes the Main Foyer, the Lindens' galleries (Teal, Pewter, and Red rooms), and the corridors of the Lindens.*

*The Center also has smaller meeting rooms as well as classrooms for our extensive offering of art classes. Artist studio space is available for rent. In addition, artists may rent space at The Center for a one-person or group show.*

*Would you like to become a juried Russell Gallery artist and have the privilege of submitting artwork to be juried for each Russell Gallery show? Drop off 5 pieces of work on Sunday, July 25, between 10 and 11 a.m. Pick up your work later that day between 12:00p.m. and 1 p.m. If selected, you will become a Russell Gallery Artist, and you may submit artwork for the new show that day or on Monday, July 26 (5-7 p.m.) and in future shows.*
