Display Your Art

Gallery Information - The Plymouth Center for the Arts has two main art galleries. The **Russell Gallery** displays artwork by juried Guild artists and is also used as a venue for small performances, functions, and larger meetings. The **Members' Gallery** is used to display unjuried artwork by Guild members and includes the Main Foyer, the Lindens' galleries (Teal, Pewter, and Red rooms), and the corridors of the Lindens.

The Center also has smaller meeting rooms as well as classrooms for our extensive offering of art classes. Artist studio space is available for rent. In addition, artists may rent space at The Center for a one-person or group show.

Become a Russell Gallery Artist - Would you like to become a juried Russell Gallery artist and have the privilege of submitting artwork to be juried for each Russell Gallery show? Jurying takes place twice a year in January and July. The January date will be announced later this year.

Cordage Marketplace Venue - Display your artwork at Cordage Marketplace in North Plymouth, home to professional offices, college, gym, karate school, etc. Large pieces are preferred in this location, or you may display a grouping of coordinated smaller pieces.
