GUILD MEMBERS' GALLERY POLICY

IN GENERAL:

- You must maintain Guild membership
- \$10 hanging fee/piece
- 1 piece per show/artist
- 30% sales commission
- Artwork may be shown only once in a calendar year.

MEMBER PARTICIPATION: 3hrs/mo.

At this time we are an entirely volunteer operation and need your help. Please choose:

- Gallery Sitting
- Set up food, etc. for receptions
- Art show registration
- Hang and move artwork
- Front desk receptionist
- Marketing
- Mailings
- Advertising
- Conduct a workshop, be a speaker
- Fundraise
- Grant Writing
- Professional services
- General Cleaning
- Another skill or ability

ARTWORK MUST BE:

- **original (no prints)**
- **for sale**

We must sell to maintain the gallery. Please keep the viewing public in mind as you select work

HANGING

You may deliver **one piece of work for each show**. If your work sells, you will be contacted to bring in a new piece with no additional hanging fee.

SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

2D ARTISTS

- Work may not exceed 36" in any direction.
- Work must be framed, fully dry, signed, properly wired (no alligator clips) and ready for hanging.
- Matting and framing should be of superior quality and complement the artwork. Old "weathered" frames should not be used.
- Wires must be taut; strong enough to hold the piece; securely attached to the frame; and installed 1/3 of the

distance from the top of the piece.

- All drawings, original prints, watercolors and photos must be under glass or Plexiglas. Clamped glass, scarred mats, cracked glass, and damaged frames are not acceptable.

3D ARTISTS

Members' artwork is primarily displayed in the foyer and hallways of the first floor of the Center. Space is limited. You may submit a small piece that may be displayed in a window or relatively flat against a wall.

FUNCTIONS

Sales could be the direct result of exposure during special events, meetings, etc. since they bring viewers into the galleries. During special events we reserve the right to **move the artwork** to other locations, leaving the work up for viewing as much as we are able.
